Mathes Brierre Architects provided professional architectural services for the development of the new Deutsches Haus which features patterned brick walls and patterned roofs at the exterior inspired by German architecture and exposed glu - laminated wood structure at the interior. Contemporary curtain wall glazing provides daylight throughout the building.

The facility will be comprised of a large meeting hall with a supporting bar and kitchen, a member's only bar, classrooms, and an outdoor beer garden.
