■ Metairie Country Club, which was designed by our predecessor firm and built in 1924, has undergone several renovations and one addition. After the club sustained extensive damage caused by Hurricane Katrina, MBA was selected to design a new addition and restore the original building to its historic grandeur. The project involved the construction of a new 13,500 SF addition, housing a 4,500 SF ballroom, pre-function space, a new banquet kitchen, and support spaces. The new building's architecture and interiors are in keeping with the historic context of the original building. In addition, the historic building was completely remodeled including all four dining rooms, the main kitchen, men's and ladies' lounges and locker rooms, and the administrative area. The scope of work also included the relocation of the swimming pool and tennis courts, expansion of the fitness center, and a new golf pro shop.
