NEW CONSTRUCTION



■ Federal City is a newly planned joint facility, distinguished by its form, function, and fiscal viability. It consolidates the two bases of the Naval Support Activity, currently located on both sides of the Mississippi River, and provides combined facilities and services for the Army, Navy, Marines, Department of Homeland Security and the Coast Guard. The new site will be a shared and protected, located on the Westbank. The new Department of Defense force structure deems the reservists “first responders” in national defense, positioning Federal City as an ideal regional headquarters for Homeland Security. The consolidation of these support commands in this location will facilitate collaboration and create a training environment that replicates conditions for emergency deployment.
